1. Call to order, roll call

The April 2, 2024 Advisory Liquor Commission meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chairman Rick Delawder. Also in attendance were: Commission Members Tony Amato, Carol Cesario and Fred Yanez; Mayor Rich Veenstra, Chief Roy Selvik, Detective Commander Frank Pope, Village Attorneys David Freeman and Patrick Miner, Alyssa Smith, and Mary Heneghan.

Representing Hammerhead Entertainment Inc. was Dean Stathopoulos.

2. Approval of the minutes of the January 9, 2024 meeting

Commission Member Cesario made a motion to recommend acceptance, seconded by Commission Member Amato. Motion approved unanimously.

3. Liquor License Application Public Hearing for Hammerhead Entertainment Inc. at 433 S. Addison Road, Class "A"

The Public Hearing notice was read, and Mary Heneghan swore in the applicant.

Mr. Stathopoulos stated that he has operated JD Muggs / Muggs N Manor here in Addison since 1998. There is an open spot in the same strip mall three spaces down where he would like to open a small gaming parlor, as there is no similar business in that area of town. This establishment would be open Monday through Saturday from 9am to 10pm, and Sunday's from 11am to 10pm. Some of his current customers would prefer a quieter location for video gaming. He does not want a "bar" type atmosphere, and will offer pre-made / pre-packaged food with everything being priced under \$6.00-\$7.00. He will have six gaming machines.

Chief Selvik and Commander Pope stated there were no issues with the background, and Mr. Stathopoulos has been running a liquor establishment for many years in town and is familiar with the regulations and procedures. He will have video surveillance at this new location for security purposes.

Commission Member Amato made a motion to recommend approval of this liquor license application, seconded by Commission Member Cesario. The next steps of the process were reviewed with the applicant.


