1. **Call to order, roll call**

The July 2, 2024 Advisory Liquor Commission meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chairman Rick Delawder. Also in attendance were: Commission Members Tony Amato, Carol Cesario, Mike Hartnett and Fred Yanez; Mayor Rich Veenstra, Village Manager Joe Maranowicz, Police Chief Roy Selvik, Detective Commander Frank Pope, Village Attorneys David Freeman and Patrick Miner, Alyssa Smith, and Mary Heneghan.

Representing Maria's Gaming Café was Maria Carli.

2. **Approval of the minutes of the June 4, 2024 meeting**

Commission Member Cesario made a motion to recommend acceptance, seconded by Commission Member Amato. Motion approved unanimously.

3. **Liquor License Application Public Hearing for MC Addison Café LLC d/b/a Maria's Gaming Café located at 40 E. Lake Street, Class "E"**

The Public Hearing notice was read, and Mary Heneghan swore in Ms. Carli.

Ms. Carli explained that she is looking to open up a gaming café with just wine and beer; food can be ordered from Dunkley's and brought over to the café. She plans on having just one employee. Commission Member Cesario asked if this was right next to Dunkley's, and Ms. Carli responded that it is 4-5 spaces down, in one of the old Michael's Driving School locations. Village Manager Maranowicz stated that the Village is not concerned with this business concept, it is similar to how Millie's operates. The hours will be similar to Dunkley's, and they may open earlier. Commission Member Amato asked if this would have any effect on their current business, and Ms. Carli replied that often times they have people waiting for the machines so this would provide another space for them. There will be space available for customers to eat if they order food over from Dunkley's.

Chief Selvik and Commander Pope stated there were no issues with the backgrounds, and there have not been any issues with Dunkley's.

Commission Member Hartnett made a motion to recommend approval of this liquor license application, seconded by Commission Member Amato. The next steps of the process were reviewed with the applicant.


