1. Call to order, roll call

The March 10, 2026 Advisory Liquor Commission meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chairman Rick Delawder. Also in attendance were: Commission Members Tony Amato, Carol Cesario, Mike Hartnett and Fred Yanez; Liquor Commissioner Hundley, Chief Selvik, Attorney Freeman, and Mary Heneghan.

Representing La Placita was Lydia Diaz.

Representing Slotty's were Jayana Patel and Akhil Thomas.

2. Approval of the minutes of the November 4, 2025 meeting

Commission Member Hartnett made a motion to recommend acceptance, seconded by Commission Member Amato. Motion approved unanimously.

3. Liquor License Application Public Hearing for La Placita Inc. located at 390 W. Lake Street, Class "D"

The Public Hearing notice was read, and Mary Heneghan swore in the applicant.

Chairman Delawder asked the applicant to explain their plans for adding alcohol to the restaurant. Ms. Diaz responded that they would like to offer alcohol as an option to their patrons, and to also add video gaming machines. Business has declined over the last 5 years, and this would assist in increasing revenues. They have a designated section where the video gaming machines would be located. The alcohol would be served to the tables. Ms. Diaz stated that she will card everyone. Chief Selvik stated the Police Department did not have any concerns, they have not had any issues with this establishment over the years and the owners are very responsible. He reviewed the Police Department's procedures on compliance checks, and explained that violations of local or state liquor laws could result in fines, suspensions, or license revocation. He encouraged Ms. Diaz to contact the police with any issues or concerns.

Attorney Freeman emphasized the extra responsibility a liquor license requires for the owners.

Commission Member Hartnett made a motion to recommend approval of this liquor license application, seconded by Commission Member Yanez. The next steps of the process were reviewed with the applicant.

4. **Liquor License Application Public Hearing for Slotty's LLC located at 607 S. Addison Road, Class "A"**

The Public Hearing notice was read, and Mary Heneghan swore in the applicant.

Chairman Delawder asked the applicants to explain their plans for the business. Mr. Thomas stated that they are buying the business from current owners, including taking over the LLC. Their plan is to keep everything the same. Prairie State Gaming will continue to be the video gaming provider. He advised that the food menu would continue, and would match what was provided in the packet to the Commission Members. The layout of the premises was also explained to the Commission Members. Chief Selvik advised there were no issues with the background checks.

Commission Member Hartnett made a motion to recommend approval of this liquor license application, seconded by Commission Member Amato. The next steps of the process were reviewed with the applicant.

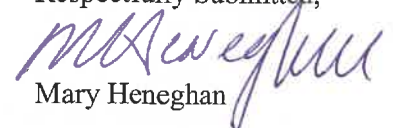
